The City of Little Rock is beginning the planning process for the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the 2011 Action Plan. The plan will outline funding and programming to be accomplished through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), and Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA) Programs. The City of Little Rock receives CDBG, HOME, and HOPWA funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Neighborhood planning meetings will be held throughout the City the week of August 2-5, and August 9, 2010. The purpose of these planning meetings is to hear concerns and needs for funding as it relates to community development and housing in the City of Little Rock and proposed Amendments to the 2010 Action Plan.
